# CHAPTER ONE INTRODUCTION

## OVERVIEW OF THE MKAN 2021/2022 YEAR

1. All praises and adoration belong to Allah who because of His sheer Grace and Benevolence enabled MKAN activities to be back in full gear. It is worthy of note that the measures taken by the Government to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 affected some of our activities in the last two years such that we resorted to virtual channels in communicating and hosting some of our activities.

## ABOUT MKAN

2. MKA is an auxiliary body of the worldwide Ahmadiyya Community, whose members range between the ages 15 and 40. The body is saddled with the task of organizing its members to promote the peaceful message of Islam to the entire World.
3. Its aims are to train and educate its members, including Atfalul Ahmadiyya (male children between the ages 7 and 15), in the true Islamic teachings, selfless service to Islam, country, and mankind at large.
4. The Nigerian Branch of Majlis Khuddamul Ahmadiyya was established in 1972 with branches across twenty (24) States of the Federation.

## OBJECTIVES

5. The principal objective of Majlis Khuddamul Ahmadiyya is the moral and spiritual training of youth through a mix of religious and secular activities. It is dedicated to ensuring its members develop and excel in qualities such as piety, honesty, and fair dealing so that they can better contribute to the country in which they live.
6. The activities of MKA are not limited to the Muslim community. It serves the needs of all members of society irrespective of colour, race, religion or creed and promotes interfaith dialogue and co-operation to promote peace and harmony.

## SERVICETO HUMANITY

7. MKA Nigeria has a long-standing reputation of working as a charity organisation and bringing succour to people affected with disaster through Humanity First Nigeria.

8. Additionally, MKA Nigeria has been working with the National Blood Transfusion Service for many years and is a regular blood donor provider throughout its branches in Nigeria. Blood donation sessions are also held at various mosques and conventions held by the Ahmadiyya Muslim Community.
9. MKA Nigeria also participates in environmental sanitation exercises across many states of Nigeria, as well as in many community services like traffic control, road rehabilitation and drainage management.
10. MKA Nigeria has been at the forefront of providing excellent educational services to both its members and non-members. It established, in conjunction with other individual Ahmadi members, an elementary school, the Fadl-i-Omar Islamic Nursery and Primary School, Ojokoro, Lagos State in 1996 through which it provides qualitative education to members of the Community. It also organizes free tutorial classes for students preparing for public examinations.
11. MKA Nigeria is actively engaged in presenting the peaceful message of Islam and removing common misconceptions and misunderstandings about the faith of Islam and all other religions. It firmly believes tolerance, engagement, interactions, and debates are vital to understanding the true teachings of Islam.
12. Since its establishment in 1972, Majlis Khuddamul Ahmadiyya Nigeria has been led by National Presidents (Sadr) with its current Sadr being Mr. AbdurRoqib Akinyemi.
13. MKA Nigeria's website is [www.khuddam.ng](http://www.khuddam.ng) where information about the organisation and its activities are regularly published.

## CHAPTER TWO DEPARTMENTS

### AIT'MAD (ADMINISTRATION)

10. The administrative structure of MKAN was maintained as in previous years, with the appointment of Naibeen Sadr (Vice Presidents) for the North Region, South-West Region, and the South-East/South-South Region, and a Naib Sadr in charge of Administration.
11. In total, MKAN conducted activities in sixteen (16) Ilaqaat, fifty-five (55) Dil'aat and two hundred and sixty-four (264) Muqameen. All these are spread over twenty-four (24) of Nigeria's thirty-six (36) administrative states and the Federal Capital Territory.
12. The Sadr Sahib attended the AMJN National Aamila, Islahi, Scholarship board, Rishtanata & Jalsa Salana Administrative Setup meetings as scheduled. The Qaideen at their various levels continued to attend their respective Circuit and Jama'at meetings and functions as required.
13. The MKAN e-Report (Web Application based) started some years ago (built by the Ishaat department). This is used in reporting majalis activities (at the subnational levels). Feedbacks on the Application has been positive with room for continuous improvement.

### KHIDMAT E KHALQ (WELFARE)

14. **Social gatherings/Welfare**
  - More than 2,000 pints of blood donated by members across the country
  - More than 20 hospitals were visited, patients were given toiletries, hospital bills of some patients paid (in full and in part). Many patients were also given relief materials.
  - Many Ilaqaat (state branches) were given award on world blood donor day in recognition of the meritorious services to different government agencies
  - Different correctional centres were visited while giving toiletries to the inmates

### TABLIGH (PREACHING)

15. **Pamphlet distribution:** 18,830 pamphlets and other Islamic literatures on various subject matters were distributed by members of MKAN.
16. **Bay'aaah:** A total number of 20 new converts to Ahmadiyya were recorded through the Tabligh activities of MKAN across Nigeria

17. **Radio programs:** 2 Members of MKAN in OYO and OSUN Ilaqa are sponsoring a radio program each. Premier FM, 93.5 (Every Wednesday 9:00 – 9:30) OSBC, 104.5FM (Once in four months)
18. **Public lecture:** 60 public lectures were organized by MKAN across Nigeria.
19. **House-to-house preaching:** 36 sessions of house-to-house preaching were organized by members of MKAN across the country.
20. **Ramadan lecture:** 5 Ilaqaat organized grand Ramadan lecture and a post Ramadan lecture.
21. Markaz-approved digital TV created by MKAN "servants of faith TV" aired 4 videos within the year under review. We also recorded 20,000 views and 500 likes.

### WAQAR-E-AMAL (COMMUNITY SERVICE)

22. **General Sanitation:** This was carried out by members of the Majlis both at the State Level and Dil'a level. This activity was thoroughly done by 60% of the Muqam.
23. **National Waqar-e-Amal:** Was carried out by members at the National Ijtema Offa 2022

### SANAT-O-TIJARAT (TRADE)

24. **Job Opportunities and Skills Acquisition Platform:** To ensure a better dissemination of information to members, an ADDITIONAL Whatsapp platform named MKAN HOT JOBS was created as one of the platforms to share job opportunities and available skill acquisition programs directly to all Ilaqa Qaideen. The platform was created on 3 July 2022 and has the Sadr sahib, his Naibeen Sadr, Mulk administrative members and all Ilaqa Qaideen as members of the platform. Over 120 job opportunities and skill acquisition programmes information had been shared in the group since inception.
25. **Seminar:** A webinar on the Basics of First aid treatment took place on the 3rd of April 2022. It was facilitated by a trained Coach Dr. Jamiu Abdul Qadir. Basics of automobile checks and driving training also held online in March 2022. Videos and training materials were shared online for members' reference and learning. In February 2022, the

basics of Computer usage and MS office suite training were done at all levels of the Majlis.

**26. MKAN Apparels Production and MKAN Uniform Cap Modification:** In October 2021, The Mulk agreed to modify the design of the MKAN uniform cap. The production and sales were jointly done by the office of the Muhtamin Sanat-o-tijarat and Umumee. Over one thousand five hundred (1,500) new caps were produced and sold to members. Also, new uniforms and accessories were produced and made available to members at the Ijtema venue.

**27. Promotion of Members' Businesses:** An MKAN member who majors in the production of footwear with the brand name - FARAH FOOTWEAR approached the Muhtamin Sanat-o-tijarat office to help his business with publicity. The office was able to help by broadcasting the member's products to members on our platforms and did a short advert video for the business free of charge.

**28. Mirza Ghulam Qadir Shaheed I.T Laboratory and Centre:** This institute was established in line with the directive of Huzoor (atba) to equip male Ahmadi (between the ages of 13 and 25) of necessary I.T skills in preparation for the fast-developing technological world. 29 young Ahmadi male and female members started the class in April 2022 while 7 ICT tutors are serving as facilitators. The program holds fortnightly at the MKAN secretariat with one two-week long boot camp held so far. It is projected that the first set of students will wrap up their course April 2023.

A similar online I.T session organised by Sanat-o-tijarat UK which took members of all ages and gender through the basics of Software development and coding. The program started March 2022 and has been substantially completed.

**29. AMJN Sanat-o-tijarat And Zirat Department Agripreneurship Workshop:** This is a week-long programme held at AMJN conference Hall, Tanke, Ilorin, Kwara state. It held between 21 - 27 March, 2022. Over 30 MKAN members attended both physically and virtually. A whatsapp platform was created for members who attended for follow ups and agriculture-related information.

#### **ISHA'AT (MEDIA & PUBLICITY)**

30. The Isha'at Department is saddled with the management of MKAN information and publications. Over the years, Isha'at has been the face of MKAN in the digital space.

31. On Social Media accounts that belong to the Majlis Khuddam Facebook fans increased to 5,892 Fans. Twitter followers increased to 5,241 followers. YouTube subscribers increased to 195 Subscribers.

32. Thousands of Al-Irfan magazines were produced in the year.

33. We work with all departments of MKAN to get their activities known to the world. We regularly work with Tarbiyya, Taleem, and Atfal among others to spread their news.

34. A weekly Friday Verse is being released on our Youtube page.

35. MKAN news is published on news.khuddam.ng regularly. We have also developed MKAN NEWS APP (<http://bit.ly/mkannewsapp>) which allows people all over the world to get access to MKAN news on the go.

36. A digital payment platform Maalify App is still in operation (<http://bit.ly/MAALIFY>) to ease payment of majlis chanda and other MKAN donations. Hundreds of people now make their payments on the app seamlessly.

#### **ISHA'AT (AUDIOVISUALS)**

37. **MTA Dish/decoder Installation Training:** Isha'at (Audio-Visual) department in conjunction with A.M.J Nigeria Audio-Visual department organized MTA Dish/decoder Installation Training on Saturday 26 February, 2022 at Ahmadiyya headquarters, Ojokoro. Mr. Abass Adegbite and Muallim Kolade Mansur anchored the programme where there are eighteen 18 members attended physically from fourteen 14 Dil'a alongside 10 crew members with facilitators. The total attendees were One hundred and thirteen (In person – 28, Virtual - 85) members. The training was recorded and documented for future reference as it clips were shared with interested Dil'a.

38. **Effective Video Production Using Smartphone Training:** The training was conducted via Zoom conference app on Sunday 27 March 2022 and the programme was anchored by Bro. Zafrullah Lamina (Content Creator and Project Manager). The live proceeding had 12 members in attendance and the recorded link for the programme was shared with other MKA Nigeria members that were unable to attend.

39. **Lecture Clips on Mkan Soundcloud:** The MKAN Soundcloud account was actively used for uploading of MKAN and Jama'at audio clips. Five

Ramadan 1443AH lecture clips were uploaded, the Ijtema 2022 Public lecture clip delivered by Muallim Muhd. Waa'iz Apooyin titled: "The Impact of Materialism on Compulsive Consumption in Nigeria" was uploaded and 69 Friday sermons of Hazrat Mirza Masroor Ahmad (atba) were uploaded from December 2021 till date in three languages (English, Yoruba, and Hausa). 75 clips in total have been uploaded on Soundcloud for members to enjoy.

40. **National Ijtema/events:** The Isha'at (Audio-Visual) team was saddled with some activities at the 2022 MKA Nigeria 48th National Convention held in Offa, Kwara State among which are: Audio-Visual, Public Address System, and Electrification of the convention site. Moreover, we honoured two invitations from Majlis Ansarullah Nigeria for setting up of camp radio at their National Workshop in Ilaro and National Ijtema in Oyo.

#### **ATFAL (CHILDREN)**

41. **Newly Adopted Atfal Syllabus:** Sequel to the instruction received by His Holliness on October 11th, 2020, in which the Huzoor said: "In the future the syllabus of Waqfe Nau children will also be the syllabus of Majlis Atfal-ul-Ahmadiyya. There is no need to have two separate syllabi for Atfal". The office of Muhtamin after consultation and deliberations released a template as syllabus for members of Atfal-ul-Ahmadiyya Nigeria on the 2nd January, 2022. The syllabus is an adopted copy of Canadian Syllabus for Members of Atfal, Nasrat and Waqfe Nau. It is sub-divided into:

- Group1: Ages 5 to 6 (We do call them VIP here; they initially didn't have a specified syllabus in the former syllabus)
- Group2: Ages 7 to 9
- Group3: Ages 10 to 12
- Group4: Ages 13 to 15

For better understanding of the syllabus, a guide was prepared for the Handlers as an assessment; a scheme of work was also developed by the Office of Muhtamin Atfal.

During the IVC/Ijtema camp, the classes held were based on the scheme of work, using the newly adopted syllabus for the Month of August. This was done to better familiarize the Handlers and kids with the syllabus.

The scheme of work had been updated from Quarter to Quarter, the current one was released on the 1st Sunday in September 2022.

42. **Atfal Examinations:** There have been two series of examination since the adoption of the new syllabus. First Quarter examination was online, it was done on the 8th of May, 2022 while the Second Quarter was a physical done at the 2022 IVC/Ijtema.
43. **Atfal Mulaqaat With the Huzoor:** On the 8th January, 2022. 50 members of Majlis Atfal-ul-Ahmadiyya across the nation, Muhtamin Atfal Team and Sadr MKAN had the opportunity to meet His holiness virtually. The Muhtamin Atfal gave Huzoor a succinct report on some activities in his office. This unforgettable experience dwelled more on questions and answer between the members of Atfal and His Holliness. A closing remark was given by Huzur Aqdas as a general advice to the kids.

44. **Nazeem Atfal Re-orientation Program And 2nd National Nazeem Atfal Exam:** Going by the popular saying: You can't give what you don't have, the Office of Muhtami Atfal, organized a re-orientation program for Atfal Handlers-- Nazeemeen Atfal – across the nation. It was a virtual program held on 5th March, 2022.

The program started with a welcome address by the Sadr MKAN, represented by Naib Sadr Admin, Alhaji Musa Abd Rahman. Engineer Saheed Aina, Former Sadr MKAN, delivered a lecture on the topic: Being the best Model for our Kids.

The second lecture was delivered by Bro Akintobi Abd Hakeem, he gave a presentation on the topic: "Etiquette of a good Teacher, Classroom Modelling". Thereafter, Missionary Abd Waaiz Apooyin gave a review on the book: Minhaju Talibeen; Ways of the seeker. Question and Answer sessions followed afterwards and comments were also made. The tajneed was 42.

45. **National Nazeem Atfal Exam 2022:** To get feedbacks on the orientation and to know how well the messages were understood, the Office of Atfal further organized an online National examination for Nazeemin Atfal in Nigeria. This Examination were based on the three lectures. The tajneed per Ilaqa are:

46. **Establishment of Mirza Ghulam Shaheed IT and Research Centre (MGQS):** Sequel to the proposal sent by the Office of Muhtamin Atfal through the Office of the Sadr MKAN for prayer and guidance on our plan to actively engage members of Atfal Nigeria in Information technology, Huzoor gave us a bigger and better one in reply.

After a long process of planning and proposals, His Holiness granted us the benefit to start the program with 20 members of Atfal and Khuddam and 10 members of Nasrat/Young Lajna.

Classes hold every fortnight at MKAN headquarters Ojokoro and a two weeks camp is to be done at during school breaks. Classes have started since February till date.

47. **Atfal Day Celebration 2022:** The Atfal day was celebrated on the 27th May 2022. The theme of the event was: "Benefits of exercises to the body and brain". The program was left in the hands of the Dil'a at and various sprint and field events were done. Some went for excursion or picnics.

48. **Atfal IVC/ Ijtema 2022:** This year regional Ijtema was held across some regions in Nigeria, it is our usual practice due to the geopolitical characteristics and morphology of the country we hold the regional 2 years on a row and one National Ijtema. The theme of this year regional ijtema was: "Our Atfal; Our future". The Ijtema was held between Monday 8th of August to Sunday 14th August, 2022.

**52. National Umumin Invited Program/Training:-**

- a. Lajna Immaillah 2022 Ijtema Security Request:** -The department received an invite from Lajna Immaillah through the Office of the Sadr Sahib to assist in the area of Jama'at Internal Security during their Ijtema held at Islamic High School, Orita Bashorun, Ibadan, Oyo between 9th - 11th September, 2022.

With the assistance of Oyo Ilaqa Qaid, SW-Umumin and Ilaqa Umumin, Oyo, arranged and deployed 20 Majlis Members extract from all Dil'a't in Oyo on shift and rotational basis to perform necessary & needed security operations throughout the Ijtema period.

Members of ASPAN and over 40 Majlis Members from Other States took part in the Security & Tactical Operational during throughout the Ijtema.

- b. FRSC Special Marshall Training:** -A training course invite was extended to the Department from Majlis Ansarullah, Nigeria to encourage Majlis Members to partake in FRSC Special Marshall Training Course. The Department was able to secure 22 Interested Majlis Applicants for the Course. Necessary Documents & Course Fee have been made available and paid.

**53. Track Record of Ilaqa Courtesy Visitation:** - The department received a Report of Courtesy Visit made by Niger Ilaqa to the Federal Road Safety Corps, State Headquarters in Minna on 17th of March, 2022 and Nigeria Security and Civil Defense Corps, Niger State on 23rd of March, 2022. ### 57. MKAN Ta'leem Workplan, 2022

At the time of making this report, 92% of the Ta'leem workplan for the year 2022 has been covered already, cutting across Qur'an, Hadith, Malfoozah, Qaseedah, Book Reviews, etc.

### 58. Ta'leem Monthly Examination

MKAN Ta'leem monthly examination was held in January and February, 2022.

Averagely, 542 members of the Majlis participated in the exams.

### 59. MKAN National Ijtema

Competitions like Qur'an, Quiz, Speech, Qaseedah and Message delivery were held during the 2022

Ijtema in Offa.

## TARBIYYA (ETHICS)

60. Six National Tarbiyyat Programs were drawn out for daily use for all auxiliary bodies in Nigeria.

61. 360 daily Spiritual lessons culled from Malfuzat tagged as 'Spiritual Nuggets' were disseminated to about 2,000 recipients.

62. An average of forty percent of the Khuddam population across the country read and/or listened to Huzur's Friday sermons on a regular basis.

63. Also, about forty percent of members reported observing their daily namaz in congregation.

64. A virtual National Workshop with the theme 'Significance of Nizāme-Jama'at' was held on 2nd October, 2022 for the spiritual training of all members, it had approximately 800 members in attendance, Alhamdulillah.

## TAHRIK-E-JADID (SPECIAL FUND)

65. Awareness was made to enlighten members on the importance of the Tahrik-e- Jadid scheme. Excerpts from the speeches and guidance from the khulafa, on this blessed scheme, was shared with members of the Majlis for their spiritual benefits.

66. Members were enlightened on the general principles of the Tahrik-e-Jadid scheme as articulated by Hazrat Musleh-e-Mao'ud (ra) who founded the scheme.

67. In addition, members were encouraged to participate sincerely and massively in the blessed scheme.

## TAJNID (POPULATION)

68. **Data entry/update:** State Qaideens, Dila Qaideens with their respective Nazimeen Tajneed play their varied roles in ensuring prompt and correct entry and also update of data on the Majlis Tajneed portal.

69. **Data Synchronization:** we have synchronized Majlis Tajneed data with that of the National Tajneed data. This synchronization exercise has facilitated the proper alignment of Majlis Tajneed data with that of the Jama'at.

70. **Use of single membership number:** the membership number used on the National Tajneed platform has been adopted on the new Majlis Tajneed portal. The number serves as a unique identifier for each member.

71. Below is the current Tajneed of both Majlis Khuddam and Atfal-ul Ahmadiyya Nigeria

#### **MAAL (FINANCE)**

72. The Maal portal (and the mobile app version, Maalify) has been developed and is currently operational. It is now fully embraced by majority of our members for seamless payments of Chanda Majlis and other contributions.

#### **TARBIYYA (RISHTANATA)**

73. A one-year workplan was developed to guide the activities of the department and drive the vision of preventing marital conflict and giving hope and solution in marital issues that may arise within the jama'at.

74. The MKAN Rishtanata Department represented the respected Sadr Majlis Khudamul Ahmadiyya Nigeria in about 10 Rishtanata meetings and family dispute resolution avenues that were set up by the headquarters, Ahmadiyya Muslim, Jama'at, Nigeria. Through these meetings:

- 15 families/couples were serviced
- Nine couples requested for divorce or dissolution of their marriage. Three of the divorce requests were painfully approved by Amirsahb.
- 7 cases of child custody and related dispute were treated.

75. We reached out to three widows to match them with suitable men.

#### **NAO MUBAEEN (NEW CONVERTS)**

76. 33 more new converts as reported from different Ilaqaat

77. The department also work in collaboration with tabligh and tarbiyyat department

78. 65% of the ilaqat are following the national work plan.

#### **UMOORE TALABAH (STUDENTS AFFAIRS)**

79. The office of Muhtamim Umoore Talabah oversees the administration of educational and human capital development of students at both secondary and tertiary levels within the Majlis. In the year, the office worked to establish a structure for implementing programmes at the local level and to create a platform for data aggregation to design effective programmes for the benefits of

students nationwide.

A summary of the key activities that occurred during the year are presented as follows:

80. **Workplan:** A workplan was designed to capture the programmes to be facilitated at local levels across the country. The workplan was approved by the Sadr, MKAN and subsequently adopted for implementation. Some of the programmes included in the workplan are Student Database Development, Academic and Career Counselling, Developing Reflective and Critical Listening and Writing Skills, Orientation for Secondary School Students, and more.

81. **Whatsapp Group Platform:** To aid effective interactions and reduce communication barriers among Nazimeen at the Ilaqah and Dil'a levels, the Sadr sahib graciously approved for a WhatsApp group to be created. The WhatsApp group was updated with the contact of newly appointed Nazimeen.

82. **AMSA National Election:** Ahmadi Muslim Students Association (AMSA) national leadership changed in December 2021 after the election conducted by members of the association. A new set of executive cabinet members were appointed, and necessary approval was received from the Sadr, MKAN sahib and correspondence shared with the Markaz for Huzur's prayers and blessings.

83. **Malaaqah with Huzur:** The Muhtamim joined AMSA National Executives to participate in the Mulaaqah granted by Beloved Huzur on the 9th of January 2022. The statistics presented to Huzur (atba) on AMSA membership across the country was 543, including students across universities, polytechnics. We noted that 26 students were studying computer science, 72 and 7 were studying engineering and medicine, respectively. Huzoor answered numerous questions posed by AMSA members and gave blessed advice for the benefits of all.

84. **AMSA Programmes:** The Muhtamim engaged regularly with key national executive members of AMSA, especially the President and General Secretary, and provided guidance on the implementation of the programmes. AMSA planned and held several programmes during the year such as First Annual Quran Competition (April 2022), AMSA FUTA Annual Propagation Week (February 2022), AMSA Ilaro Annual Propagation Week (September 2022), and AMSA National Annual Higher Institution Conference 2022

(October 2022). Owing to ongoing national strike by the Academic Staff Union of Universities (ASUU), many students were not in campuses, and this has affected programmes across all institutions, except for a few.

**85. Scholarship and Internship Opportunities:**

Through the WhatsApp Platform, over 30 scholarships and internship opportunities were shared with Nazimeen for onward dissemination to students within their localities. Also, several useful resources for personal development were shared with AMSA members on their WhatsApp Platform. The Muhtamin engaged with AMSA executives to ensure the useful resources reached the local units so that wider membership can benefit from them.

**86. Counselling Session at MKAN 2022 Ijtema:**

During the Ijtema held in Offa, Kwara State, the Muhtamim had a counselling session with AMSA executives and some other AMSA members on intellectual development, academic performance, and general personal development. Over 20 students participated in the session, and they were all encouraged to share key learnings with peers across several platforms.

**87. Academic Excellence Award Presentation at the**

**Ijtema:** In recognition of the exemplary performance of students who distinguished themselves in various disciplines and across different institutions, the Office of UmooreTalabah worked with the Aitmad to compile the names of first- class, high second class upper, and postgraduate students. The Sadr Sahib and other eminent invited guests presented the awardees with their plaques and certificates of achievement. A total of fifteen (15) awards were presented to 15 awardees (two awards were presented to the immediate past Sadr Dr Taofik Sanni for his two fellowships in the medical field). Three members received recognition for completing their PhD programmes in Education, Crop Physiology and Environmental Science.

## ANNUAL NATIONAL IJTEMA

94. The Majlis Khuddamul Ahmadiyya Nigeria (MKAN) by the grace of Allah held her 48th Annual Ijtemaat the Offa Grammar School, Offa Kwara State on the theme **Youths and Materialism; The Unending Quest for Worldliness**. The Ijtema started with preliminary activities from Monday, 6th June 2022 through Thursday 19th, June 2022.

On Monday, 6th June 2022, the Sadr, Brother AbdulRoqib Akintunde Akinyemi sahib and the advance team arrived at Offa in preparation for the Ijtema. On arrival, He was received by top echelon of the Jamaat in the Circuit led by the Circuit President and Kwara Ilaqa leadership of MKAN.

On Tuesday 7th June, 2022 there was a press conference with Tiwan-tiwa TV and Okin Radio Station.

## ANNUAL NATIONAL WORKSHOP

95. The 2021 Officer's workshop was held in hybrid form (i.e Physical and Virtual) due to the prevalent COVID-19 Pandemic coupled with government efforts to control over-crowding. The workshop was held on Saturday July 3rd, 2021 and Sunday 4th July 2021 respectively with thought provoking lectures which cut across; The need to reconsider polygamy: Rising case of promiscuity, homosexuality, single motherhood and immoralities by Dr. Saheed O. Timehin. Morality Disharmony and intimate partner abuse by Missionary (Barrister) Bashirudeen Badr, Increase in Cyber crime among youth by Muallim AbdulWaiz Apooyin. Each session had a fair share of Panelists who discussed Marital unfaithfulness: Role of peer pressure, Bad company and social media and immoralities in the Children: the role of Parents respectively.

It is however worthy to note that 29 Dila'at participated with over 2000 members and invited guests across board.

## STOP THE CRIME CAMPAIGN

96. Stop the crime campaign, an annual program of Majlis Khuddamul Ahmadiyya, Nigeria to sensitize young people against crime and encourage peaceful coexistence within the society.
