CHAPTER ONE INTRODUCTION

ABOUT MKAN

- 1. Majlis Khuddamul Ahmadiyya (MKA), literally meaning 'Association of Servants of the True Islam' and also known as the Ahmadiyya Muslim Youth Organization (AMYO), was founded in 1938 by Hadhrat Mirza Bashiruddin Mahmud Ahmad (ra) and is the youth section of the Ahmadiyya Muslim Community.
- 2. Consisting Ahmadi members between ages 15 and 40, Majlis Khuddamul Ahmadiyya (MKA) is an auxiliary organization of the Worldwide Ahmadiyya Community, saddled with the task of organizing members of the Ahmadiyya Muslim Jama'at between the ages of seven and forty years to present the peaceful message of Islam to the entire world.
- 3. Its aims are to train and educate its members, including Atfalul Ahmadiyya, (male children between ages 7 and 15) in the true Islamic teachings, selfless service to Islam, country and mankind at large.
- 4. Since its establishment in Nigeria in 1972, the Majlis Khuddamul Ahmadiyya Nigeria has established a culture of Service to Humanity, a tradition which is in consistent with the Ahmadiyya philosophy – "Love for All, Hatred for None" – by carrying out projects and programmes that benefit the various communities where it is established. The Khuddam operates in 21 States of Nigeria and carry out a number of projects at national, state and local government levels.

AIMS & OBJECTIVES

- 5. The principal objective of Majlis Khuddamul Ahmadiyya is the moral and spiritual training of youth through a mix of religious and secular activities. It is dedicated to ensuring its members develop and excel in qualities such as piety, honesty, and fair dealing so that they can better contribute to the country in which they live.
- 6. The activities of MKA are not limited to the Muslim community. It serves the needs of all members of society irrespective of colour, race, religion or creed and promotes interfaith dialogue and co-operation to promote peace and harmony.

SERVICETO HUMANITY

- 7. MKA Nigeria has a longstanding reputation of working with charities and bringing succour to people affected with disasters. This work ranges from assisting the charities with fundraising to organising charity events.
- 8. Additionally, MKA Nigeria has been working with the National Blood Transfusion Service for many years and is now a regular donor provider throughout its branches in Nigeria. Blood donation sessions are now held at various mosques belonging to the Ahmadiyya Muslim Community.
- 9. MKA Nigeria also participates in monthly environmental sanitation exercises across many states of Nigeria.

EDUCATIONAL SERVICES

10. MKA Nigeria has been at the forefront of providing excellent educational services to both its members and nonmembers. It established, in conjunction with other individual Ahmadi members, an elementary school, the Fazl-Omar Nursery and Primary School at Ojokoro Lagos State in 1996 to provide qualitative education to members of the Community. It also organizes free tutorial classes for students preparing for public examinations.

HEALTH AND FITNESS

11. Sports events such as football, Taekwondo, ping pong are held on a national, regional and local basis. At national events, which are rotated annually with different regions given the responsibility of organising them, regions compete against each other for the crown in that particular sport. Apart from the physical competitiveness of these events, and regional or local rivalries, members get the opportunity to meet, network and, most importantly, develop bonds of brotherhood with other members from all around Nigeria. MKA Nigeria also promotes a biennial National Sports Festival.

ISLAM AWARENESS

12. MKA Nigeria is actively engaged in presenting the peaceful message of Islam and removing common misconceptions and misunderstandings about the faith. It firmly believes that tolerance, engagement, interaction and debate are vital to understand the true teachings of Islam. It is involved in a number of programmes ranging from providing Islamic literature to a wide-ranging public. It also publishes a bi-annual magazine Al-'Irfan to educate youth and promote the reading culture. MKA Nigeria also runs a $we bsite (www.khuddam.ng) \ where information about the organization and its activities are updated.$

CHAPTER TWO DEPARTMENTS

KHIDMAT E KHALQ (WELFARE)

This is the annual report for the office of khidmat-e-khalq

- Various activities were carried out nationwide from Ilaga to Dil'a to Mugami
- Blood donation: More than 2,000 pints of blood were donated across all llagaat
- Welfare visitation: 1000+ members were reached out to.
- Correctional facilities were visited, where more than 2,000 inmates were met and provisions worth more than N250,000 were given to them.
- 15 sick members were visited at their various hospitals and various medical items were given to them in support.
- More than 10 motherless homes were visited and various items were donated to them.
- Helping hands were rendered to those affected by the Owo church attack (pints of blood were donated to the victims), we were also able to render a helping hand to those affected by natural disaster i.e flood etc.

TABLIGH (PREACHING)

The Tabligh department is saddled with the responsibility of propagating the message of Islam as explained by the Promised Messiah AS and his Khulafaa to all parts of the word. This task is of two branches; empowering members with the required knowledge of the pristine Islam (Ta'leem) and propagating the message to others.

In this year, several tasks have been undertaken to achieve this purpose and below is the breakdown.

SCOPE OF WORK:

The efforts of the department are channelled towards propagating the true Islam within and outside the Jama'at. Great focus was given to the non-Muslim and non-Ahmadi communities.

Activities and Achievements:

- 1) 30 Tabligh Classes with an estimated Tajnid of 300 members.
- 2) 13 Public lectures with not less than 400 Tajnid.
- 3) 98 episodes of radio programs reaching an estimated audience of 10,000.
- 4) 16,000 copies of pamphlets were shared.
- 5) 11 Bai'at recorded.
- 6) 19 Eminent Muslim scholars visited across the Majaalis.
- 7) 10 Facebook Tabligh programs on servant of faith TV watched by 25,000 people.

Conclusion:

The Tabligh activities this year have been both physical and virtual and we hope to explore the latter more in the coming years due to its potentials.

ISHA'AT (MEDIA & PUBLICITY)

The Isha'at Department is responsible for managing MKAN's information and publications. It is the face of Majlis Khuddamul Ahmadiyya, Nigeria in the digital space, and it works with all MKAN departments to share their activities with the world.

Scope of Work

The Isha'at Department's scope of work includes:

- Managing MKAN's social media presence
- Producing publications, such as the Al Irfan magazine and the Al Irfan Bulletin
- Collaborating with other MKAN departments to share their activities
- Maintaining MKAN's website and digital portal
- Developing and managing MKAN's digital payment platform

Achievements

In 2023, the Isha'at Department achieved the following:

Scope of Work

There is a workplan to be followed by the Ilaqa, Dil'a and down to the Muqami. The activities in the work plan is to be carried out by the members and reported accordingly. These activities are reported on a monthly basis.

Activities and Achievements for the year 2023

The Sanat-o-tijarat work plan which has been shared since the beginning of the 2022/2023 imarat has been the guide for training of members in skills acquisition through out the year at different level of the Majlis.

Job opportunities, skill acquisition programs, ICT and agricultural training opportunities etc have been frequently shared among members to benefit from.

This is the done majorly on our social media platforms that comprises all state Qaideen for easy dissemination of information.

Majlis members have also benefited from some of the business webinars organised by the Jama'at as well. One of such programmes is the webinar "IDEA GENERATION, PROPOSALS AND FINANCING OF SMALL AND MEDIUM SCALE ENTREPRISES" held online on the 26th August, 2023 and well attended by a lot of Majlis members.

Also, a monthly seminar series has been organised for Artisans to learn skills needed for upscaling their businesses. The first phase was integrated with the Jama'at's webinar held on the 26th August, 2023. The series continues as a monthly activity.

The department also manages the sales of the Majlis uniforms and apparels and ensures they are available for members consumption through out the year.

The department plans to intensify efforts on training of members on skills necessary for business growth and also to reduce the rate of unemployment in the coming year Insha Allah.

ISHA'AT (AUDIOVISUALS)

Sharing Of Huzur Weekly Friday Sermons

The MKAN Isha'at (Audio-Visual) team shares weekly Huzur Friday sermons across all MKAN controlled platforms for wider publicity to the members of the Jama'at. Forty (40) Huzur Weekly Friday sermons of Hazrat Mirza Masroor Ahmad atba were shared from November 2022 till date in four languages (English, Yoruba, Hausa and Urdu).

Lecture Clips On MKAN Soundcloud

The MKAN Soundcloud account was used for uploading of MKAN and Jama'at audio clips. Seven (7) Huzur Weekly Friday sermons of Hazrat Mirza Masroor Ahmadatba were uploaded from November 2022 till December 2022 in three languages (English, Yoruba and Hausa). Twenty-One (21) clips in total have been uploaded on the Soundcloud for members to exploit and enjoy before the expiration of the subscription which has been factored in the new year budget to continue enjoying the service.

National litema/Events

The Isha'at (Audio-Visual) team was saddled with some activities at the 2023 MKA Nigeria 49th National Convention held in Owo, Ondo State among which are: Audio-Visual, MKAN Radio and Public Address System of the convention site. The MKAN Radio local frequency of 105.5MHz was set-up at the 2023 Ijtema and the online radio was activated via: https://khuddam.ng/MKANradio. The online radio was first of its kind in any MKAN event and it recorded a total listener of 492 with 245 as unique listeners but with an average of 10 listeners at a go for peak

listeners. We also recorded the following listeners: 3 from United State, 11 from United Kingdom, 2 from Russia, 4 from Qatar and others from Nigeria. Moreover, there was an invitation that will be honored by God's grace from Majlis Ansarullah Nigeria for the use of MKAN Radio at their forthcoming National Ijtema scheduled to hold at Apata-Ibadan, in Oyo State from 18th – 20th August, 2023. The Audio-Visual unit team do take proper coverage of all events proceedings from educational, sport, symposium, lectures and courtesy visitation and can be accessed online on AMJ Audio-Visual YouTube page via: https://www.youtube.com/@AMJNAudio-VisualStudio (https://www.youtube.com/playlist?list=PLH-CBrp_fnuKfe-t4Qyrl-APeOLZS4ARP) while the Public Address System unit equally did a fantastic job.

Inventory Of MKAN Assets

The MKAN Isha'at Audio-Visual team conducted inventory of assets and properties as instructed by the Sadr Sahib and report was forwarded to the office of Muavin Sadr as advised. This activity was concluded on 14th December, 2022 and result shows that MKAN has two complete set for MKANRadio equipment/devices, twenty-two (22) AKT Floodlights with twenty-one (21) AKT bulbs alongside rolls of electrical cables for electrification. Moreover, as part of the approved budget for 2022/2023 imarah; a public address bluetooth speaker (World-king 300W public address speaker) was purchased to assist in amplifying member's message during meetings and events and it has been added to the inventory of the Majlis.

Coverage Of MKAN Mulk Activities

The MKAN Isha'at Audio-Visual team in conjunction with A.M.J Audio-Visual team handled the coverages of MKAN activities such as: 2022 Shoora Programme, five (5) MKAN Amila Mulk hybrid meetings, graduation ceremony of Mirza Ghulam Qadir Shaheed Research Lab and Centre (MGQS) programming trainees (1st cohort) among others.

ATFAL (CHILDREN)

The Atfal Department is saddled with the responsibilities to equip the members of Majlis Atfal-ul- Ahmadiyya Nigeria with the basic Islamic tenets and Ahmadiyya principle as well as moral training via the network support network of Majlis Khuddam-ul-Ahmadiyya and selected members of Ansarullah known as Murabil-Atfal. Besides, all the statutory duties, the department performs other welfare centric responsibilities to entire members of Ahmadiyya. The Statutory activities are guided by Atfal calendar which runs from November to October including our daily and weekly Dars.

Daily and Week Dars: The regular dars-ul- Islam is held at every localities across the country during the weekend and for few also in the night between Maghrib and Isha.

Monthly and Quarterly Camping: The members of Atfal whose population spread across Dila'at (districts) are gathered at designated mosque for intensive classes once in a month. It starts mostly on Friday and ends on Sundays.

Hence, the the activities to that culminated into annual report include not only the training of Atfal Handlers, quarterly examination, virtual Atfal meetings surveys, design of scheme of work from the approved syllabus, planning of yearly programmes but also cooling and distribution of sachet water and confectionery at Jalsa. The details of these activities are as follows:

National Atfal Quarterly Examination: The department conducted examination for all members of Atfal across all individual age groups. The first and second quarter of the examination were held in April and August.

National ATFAL Handlers' Retreat 2023: In an effort to improve productivity and efficiency of the handlers nationwide, a 2day workshop was staged with the approval of Sadr Majlis Khuddam-ul-Ahmadiyya Nigeria, Bro. Abdul Rogeeb Akinyemi Sahib. The aim of this programme was to fortify the children's teachers with requisite skills and knowledge to discharge their duties in accordance with prescription in the syllabus and global Ahmadiyya standards. Likewise the programme featured book review and examination. Moreover, outstanding participants were rewarded handsomely. The retreat was attended by 98 participants both offline and online.

ATFALIJTEMA/IVC 2023

The theme of this year IVC/ Ijtema was, "SALAT". The program started on Monday 7th August and ended on Sunday 13th August, 2023. Educational events such as Quran competition (which had four categories, Qaseedah, Salat Practice, Message Delivery, Quiz Competition and some more. In addition various sports were held. The program also gave the children opportunity to learn and socialize with themselves through interaction and excursion strengthening brotherhood right from now. Other events were, symposium, Darsul Islam Classes, Career Talk, Jumaat Services among others.

On-line Survey of Atfal Classes: The department got connected to Atfal Classes across all levels to assess compliance to National Curriculum sent from the National Atfal Department. It was also an avenue for Atfal Members to see what and how it is being held in another place. The Atfal made use of this opportunity to pass advices to the children and to guide the Nazimeen Atfal on ways to overcome any particular challenge. However, the team discovered that most Dila'at were not operating based on the prescription in the syllabus.

Formulation and Dissemination of Scheme: The scheme of work was designed to breakdown the approved syllabus into teachable units that are attainable with the specific period time. During Jalsa, the team was delegated to serve water and confectioneries to participants at the male Jalsa Gah in 2022. The Muhtamin and the Naibeen were supported by 20 Nazimeen Atfal from Lagos, Oyo, Ogun, Ondo and Ekiti and 4 Waqfeen Nau and 50 members of Majlis Atfal-ul-Ahmadiyya Nigeria. The Atfal Ijtema for this year was also a regional Ijtema, which included Islamic Vacation Course/ Ijtema. It was held in 7 different regions in Nigeria, with the Northern region having almost 4 locations all together and the South-South/South-East having 2 locations.

UMUMI (SPECIAL DUTIES)

The department has experienced series of growths and developments in areas such like building human capacity, strength and resource personnels, improved professional security and safety operations, developed conflicts management and public interaction, etc.

More proper recognitions, robust operations and engagement were being accorded to all members operating under the department within and outside the Ahmadiyya Muslim Jamaat, especially due to their physical appearance and interpersonal relationship and communication skills.

Professional and Standard trainings have also been adopted by the department, which guide and improve the Department Standard Operational Procedure, Engagement and Ethics.

Scope of Work: Nazim'Umumi shall perform the affairs assigned to him by the Qa'id Majlis.

Tasks/Scope of Duty

- Complete assignments given by the National Markaz, Dil'a, Ilaqa and/or Qa'id Majlis with diligence.
- Remain knowledgeable about the events in the neighborhood. Any incidents requiring immediate attention should be reported to the Markaz without any delay.

- Keep the Qa'id Majlis informed about the situation in the local area.
- Make appropriate arrangements for the safety and security of all Jama`at properties.
- Ensure that all Jama`at and Majlis functions are held in a safe environment.
- Ensure that all Jama'at premises are secured during Jumat, Eid, and other events in an organized manner
- Prepare for emergency in coordination with local Jama'at
- Create a team of dedicated people (Special Squad) committed to serve at local, regional and national events including National Ijtema and Jalsa Salana
- Keep track of all incidents as reported by various sources and do follow up actions.
- Encouraging Majalis to keep track of crime reports in the area around mosque by using local police crime reports and meeting them. Also Majalis should keep track of severe weather events including windstorm, heavy rains etc.
- Update the database of all the locations where Jumat service is offered with all the Umoomi relevant details.
- Organize trainings for Khuddam on driving, bicycle and motorcycle riding
- Organize training on self-defense for the Khuddam.

Majlis Khuddam Ijtema

This year Majlis Khuddam Ijtema was held between 8th - 11th June, 2023 at Imade College, Owo, Ondo State. The Department served in all capacity to ensure adequate and proper security and safety of life and properties were guaranteed through the period of the event.

There was no record of casualties and insurgent on or before the program.

Scope of Work

The scope of the activities of the Maal department ranges from statutory responsibilities, daily activities, monthly activities, and other occasional duties that arose in the cause of discharge of the department's obligations.

Activities and Achievements for the Year 2023

Some of the activities and achievements of the Maal department for the 2023 MKAN year are as reported below.

Reorganization of the MKAN Finance Platform & Profiling of Members on Maal portal: At the beginning of the 2022/2023 MKAN Year, the need to reshuffle participants on the MKAN Finance platform arose due to changes in members designation across all levels. The Maal department requested for and collated details of Qaideen and Nazimeen Maal with the use of a Google forms; this assisted the team to proceed with reorganization of participants on the platform and profiling of Qaideen and Nazimeen Maal in order to carry out their respective responsibilities especially on Maal portal.

Jalsa Salana Duty (Accommodation): The Maal team was assigned accommodation duty at the Jalsa Salana 2022. The team was saddled with the responsibility of supervising Ipokia and Jamia Muqami in ensuring that the accommodation duties of the Jalsa Salana were executed. Based on this, the team worked with Alhaji Engr. M. A. Ali to accomplish the assigned task.

Monthly Reminder on Chanda Majlis and litema Fund payment: The Chanda Majlis and litema payment tops the list of the different payment stipulated by the Majlis. Hence, the Maal department sends out reminders to members at the end of the month urging them to fulfil their financial obligations. The reminder memo or fliers were shared through the MKAN Mulk and MKAN Finance WhatsApp platforms so that Qaideen and Nazimeen Maal can disseminate to the grassroots.

Facilitation of E-Fliers on Payment of Atfal Subsidy: The Atfal Subsidy which is currently fixed at N1,000 is an annual fee payable by every member of the Majlis. The fund is meant to augment and support expenses incurable on Atfal Ijtema and other Atfal programs across the nation. In lieu of this, the Maal department worked with the Isha'at team to come up with E-fliers to raise awareness and generate more funds. These fliers went across members, and the effect of the distributed fliers was felt. In addition to this, update on Atfal subsidy payment as per Ilaqaat was shared frequently to inform Qaideen and members of their performance and encourage them to make more commitment.

Receipt and Disbursement of Ijtema Funds and Expenses: In preparation for the MKAN Ijtema 2023, the Maal department prepared the litema budget based on the proposed estimate submitted by the relevant departments. This budget was further assessed and approved by the Ijtema Organizing Committee. Further to this, The Maal department effectively disbursed funds to departments that needed to incur expenses for Ijtema purpose before, during and after the Ijtema. After the Ijtema, a proper account was prepared and reported coupled with the activities report which was required by the IOC.

Payment of Chanda Majlis Retention: In line with the intention of the Respected Sadr Sahib on prompt payment of Chanda Majlis retention of Majaalis, the Maal department analysed the financial status and liquidity of the Majlis, advised the Sadr Sahib and got his approval to disburse retention according. During the financial year, the retention for July 2022 to April 2023 have been paid, while the ones due for payment are still outstanding due to the current financial position of the Majlis. Yet, they are currently being considered for payment before the Majlis Shoorah.

Monthly Report of Financial Performance: The Maal department on a monthly basis, prepares and presents financial reports of Majaalis at the Mulk meeting which consists of the core Mulk officers and Qaideen. The monthly report includes Chanda Majlis payment and number of payers, Ijtema fund payment, core Mulk officers' payment status, Atfal Subsidy and other reports as the need may arise. On 3rd of July 2023, the Sadr Sahib requested that a trend analysis of Chanda Majlis payment be included in the monthly report henceforth. This took effect from July 2023 meeting where report for June 2023 was given and has come to stay. These reports were further shared on the MKAN Mulk platform and MKAN Finance platform for information and update purpose.

Record of MGQS Account: By virtue of establishment, Mirza Ghulam Qadir Shaheed IT Lab and Centre (MGQS) is under the supervision and control of the Majlis as approved by Huzur Aqdas. The Muhtamin Maal, Bro Habeebllah Onifade being one of the management staff of the institute keeps financial records and accounts on behalf of the Maal department. The separate and consolidated income and expenditure account for the 2022/2023 Training session and budget for 2023/2024 training session were prepared and presented accordingly. These records and accounts are reflected in the Majlis's books of accounts.

Response to Members Enquiry and Requests: Due to the peculiarity and nature of the department, members usually require explanations and assistance with respect to use of Maalify and the Maal portal for the purpose of payments. The MKAN Finance WhatsApp platform has been an interactive avenue to respond to members' demands. However, the Maal team responds to members' individual requests and demands. This does not only ensure that members are well educated on discharge of their financial obligations, but also makes them confident with the use of the Maal payment platforms.

Provision of Information Requested from Sadr MKAN: The respected Sadr Sahib on July 3rd 2023, requested that the Maal department provide the following:

- a. Number of Chanda Majlis payers from November 2022 till May 2023;
- b. Top 20 Chanda Majlis payer;
- c. Tajneed of members per llaquat;
- d. Flier design for statutory funds; and
- Trend analysis of Chanda Majlis performance.

The above information were actualized and reported on July 6th, 2023.

Implementation of Single Sign-On (SSO) on the Maal Portal: Recent development has met with the Tajneed portal one of which is the Single sign-on (SSO) authentication - an identification method that enables users to log in to multiple applications and websites with one set of credentials. The Tajneed team has launched the new Tajneed admin portal for Qaideen and Nazimeen Tajneed to manage the Tajneed of members within their jurisdiction. Individual members can also personally manage their information using the new My Tajneed Portal. The objective is to enable members use a single password for all Majlis portals.

The Maal department communicated the Sadr Sahib's directive for members to participate in the migration process. To achieve this, members were enjoined to visit the My Tajneed portal via http://my-tajneed.khuddam.ng to reset/update their password from password123 to their preferred Single Sign-on (SSO) password. The password 123 that was in use for signing-in to the Maal portal was replaced by the preferred SSO password. A window of one week was given to members to get onboarded for the implementation, while Sunday 6th August 2023 was communicated as the effective date.

Activation of Maalify on App Store: Since the introduction of the Majlis electronic payment platform, the Maal portal and Android version of Maalify have been the platforms available for members. iOS users usually use the Maal portal for Chnada payment purpose. In lieu of this, the need to onboard Maalify on App Store was conceived and realized. After several efforts from the concerned stakeholders, the Maalify iOS was finally approved and set up on App Store on the 16th of August 2023. By implication, members who use iOS-enabled devices can now make payments with the Maalify iOS. The Maalify iOS which can be installed on the App Store via https://apps.apple.com/ng/app/maalify/id6461532539 is compatible with iPhone and iPod touch iOS 10.0 or later.Also, the use of the Maalify iOS is in line with the existing Maal portal procedures and development.

Engagement of MKAN Lagos Amila, MKAN Kano Ilaqa and Ogun Ilaqa Nazim Maal on use of Maal Portal and New development: The Amila members of Lagos Ilaqa received the Muhtamin Maal, Bro Habeebllah Onifade at the Atfal Ijtema of Lagos Ilaqa held between August 6th and 8th 2023 at Ahmadiyya Science College Ijede, where he enlightened members on the use of Maal portal and gave a step-by-step procedure on the activation of SSO on Maal portal and password reset.

In the same vein, the Naib Muhtamin Maal Bro Yusuf Salaam had a virtual train the trainer session with a member of Kano Ilaga on April 28, 2023 on the use of Maal portal. Kano Ilaga Qaid placed the request to the Maal department in lieu of the Ilaga's workshop where members would be trained and engaged on individual and bulk payment processing on the Maal portal. Prior to this, the Muhtamin Maal also had a one-on-one session with the Nazim Maal Ogun Ilaqa Bro Sodiq Adeniran on the nitty-gritty of Maal portal on April 23 2023.

Preparation of 2022/2023 Accounts & Proposed Budget for 2023/2024: The Maal department has requested all department heads of the MKAN Aamila Mulk to propose the income and expenditure for their respective offices for the next MKAN financial year. However, 14 out of 17 departments have submitted the proposed budget as requested.

In readiness for the next MKAN Year 2023/2024, the books of account for the concluding year are being closed. Sequel to this, the Maal department has prepared the SOFP, gotten the Bank Statements handy and concluded the Statement of Income and Expenditure; these have been provided to the office of the Muhasib upon request.

Proposal on Review of Chanda Majlis Operation 180 to 250, Reservation of Chanda Majlis Retention of Jama'at Staff at the Mulk & MGQS on the Maal Portal: Following the resolution of the MKAN management meeting held on 23 July 2023 on the above heading, the Sadr Sahib at the August Mulk Meeting unveiled the position of the management to reserve the right to keep Chanda Majlis retention of MKAN members working with the Jamaat at the Mulk level for members' understanding and consideration. Qaideen have always agitated for the distribution of such retention accordingly.

Another issue discussed at the management meeting is the review of operation 180 on Chanda Majlis to operation 250 which becomes pertinent and realistic with the current situation. This was also communicated by the Muhtamin Maal at the August Mulk meeting with the approval of the Sadr Sahib. Below is the summary of the existing and proposed amount.

Existing Operation 180: Land and Building – 100, Welfare – 30, Vehicle – 10, Scholarship – 10, Tabligh – 10, Sport -10, Taalim - 10T

Proposed Operation 250: Land and Building – 100, Welfare – 50, Vehicle – 30, Scholarship – 30, Tabligh – 20, Sport-10, Taalim - 10

In addition to the proposed review, MGQS will feature as a voluntary donation field on the Maal portal to generate funds for the Mirza Ghulam Qadir Shaheed IT Lab and Centre, Nigeria.

The above proposals have passed the Mulk level and would be proposed at the Shoora for final deliberation and approval.

Efforts on Update of Signatories to Accounts: Seguel to the changes in the MKAN Aamila Mulk for 2022/2023 MKAN Year, there arose the need to update signatories to the MKAN Bank accounts. The Maal department after several efforts have updated these bank details and signatories to the account, while a few updates are under conclusion.

Recommendation

One of the objectives of setting up the Maal portal is to ensure seamless payment process and proper payment record keeping. Hence, Ilaqaat and Dil'aat should educate and encourage members to interact with the Maal portal, make payment and get acquainted with it. Bulk payment and remittance should be decentralized and limited to Muqameen to increase compliance and avoid late remittance and error in payment due to bulky transactions being logged at the Dil'a and Ilaqa level. Rather, Dil'aat and Ilaqaat should take up the duty of coordinating and monitoring the level of compliance and performance of their members and respective Mugameen in this regard.

However, we can not rule out exceptional situations that may require Dil'aat and Ilaquat to log and remit payment, but this should be minimized as much as possible.

Conclusion

With a high level of humility, the activities of the Maal department are neither limited to nor exhaustive of the above headings. Rather, we have only selected those activities considered worthy of report for the purpose of simplicity and conciseness.

TAHRIK-E-JADID (SPECIAL FUND)

The Tahrik-e-Jadid Department of the Majlis Khudamul Ahmadiyya, is charged with the duty to ensure adequate sources of the aims and objectives of the blessed scheme of Tahrik-e-Jadid, as initiated by Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih II. The department is also obliged to work assiduously, in whatever goal and directives given by His Holiness, Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih (may Allah be his helper).

In respect to the above, below is the annual report for the year 2022/2023.

Scope of Work:

The National office of MKAN Tahrik-e-Jadid, worked within the scope of the general Majaalis, from the Mugam to the Mulk levels. Activity reports are submitted by respective Qaideen every month, on: Number of payers, Amount paid, Special incidences relating to the scheme, etc: The year under review, i.e. 2022/2023, is the last year of Daftar V that was inaugurated by His Holiness Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V(may Allah be his helper). Each Daftar consists of 19 years.

Activities:

For the year under review, the following are the various activities of the department, spanning through the Mugam to Mulk levels.

Collation of Tahrik-e-Jadid promises: In February 2023, the collation of data on both number of participants and amount promised by members of the Majlis was made, through the Muqam Qaideen. Entries were recieved from 33 Mugameen in 22 Dil'aat. 223 members were recorded to have participated in the promises.

Sensitization, enlightenment and reminders: Every month, reminders were rolled out through the Ilaqa Qaideen, on the expected activities for the month in accordance with the Annual workplan, as approved by the respected Sadr Sahib.

In addition to the monthly sensitization, a speech was delivered on the Aims and Objectives of Tahrik-e-Jadid, during the 2023 MKAN National Ijtema at Owo, Ondo State.

Correspondence:

A circular dated 28th November, 2022 was recieved from Markaz, through the General Secretary, Ahmadiyya Muslim Jama'at of Nigeria. The circular relayed the directives to uphold the Tahrik-e-Jadid rules and regulations, as revised in 2023. Through the respected Sadr Sahib, In March 2023, the office of the Muhtamim Tahrik-e-Jadid was in reciept of the 1st Quarter of the Tahrik-e-Jadid record in the year under review, from the National Headquarters.

Recommendations:

Qaideen of all respective Majaalis are encouraged to assist in due reporting every month, and to put their utmost efforts in responding to directives.

A joint drive is necessary, between the National Headquarters and MKAN in fostering a balanced record of participation and contributions, on auxiliary bodies basis, in order to ensure compliance to the directives of Huzur, Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V (my Allah be his helper), on generating accurate reports by MKAN.

TAJNEED (POPULATION)

Tajneed Department is pleased to provide members with insights into her dedicated efforts in managing and safeguarding the essential records that form the backbone of the organization. As the custodians of membership data, our department plays a pivotal role in ensuring the smooth functioning of the organization. Over the past years, we have continued to uphold our commitment to accuracy, security, and accessibility in the management of membership data.

Scope of Work

The Tajneed Department is responsible for managing and maintaining accurate records of all MKAN members. This scope of work outlines the specific tasks and responsibilities of the department for the year.

Objectives:

- 1. Ensure the synchronization of data from the National Tajneed portal with the Majlis Tajneed portal
- 2. Ensure the accuracy and integrity of membership data.
- 2. Provide efficient access to membership information for authorized personnel.
- 3. Enhance data security and privacy measures.
- 4. Support the organization's strategic goals through data insights.

Scope Statement:

This scope of work covers all activities related to membership record management, including data entry, validation, security measures, and data reporting.

Deliverables:

Recommendation

1. Data Analytics for Informed Decision-Making

2. Data update awareness

Continue to create awareness on the need for members to update their data via their respective Jamaat president or Tajneed office on the National Central Tajneed system.

3. Create awareness on the membership number as unique means of identification

Time-to-time awareness should be created so all MKAN members understand what the membership number stands for.

Conclusion

In conclusion, the Tajneed Department has made significant strides in the management and maintenance of membership records during the year. We have successfully ensured data accuracy, improved security, and enhanced accessibility for our members and authorized officers. The accomplishments of the department reflect our commitment to providing quality services to our members.

The Tajneed Department remains dedicated to its mission of maintaining accurate and secure Tajneed records. We extend our gratitude to our members for their trust and cooperation and look forward to another year of serving the organization with excellence.

TARBIYYA (RISHTANATA)

Introduction:

With the special guidance of our beloved Huzoor, Hazrat Mirza Masroor Ahmad (ATBA) and his Holiness Instruction to activate the Nizame-Jama'at. The MKAN Rishtanata department obeyed this instruction and worked closely with the National Rishtanata Department and Islahi committee to collectively focus and give rishtanata related issues the best outcome as instructed by his Holiness in order to uphold the institution of marriage.

The rishtanata department also got special direction and assistance from our respected Amir, Ahmadiyya Muslim Jama`at of Nigeria – Alhaji Abdul Azeez Alatoye and Sadr, Majlis Khudamul-Ahmadiyya, Nigeria – Bro. Abdul Roqeeb Akintunde Akinyemi.

Scope of Work:

- 1. Train and educate the members regarding the importance and sanctity of the institution of marriage with Islam, as well as importance of timely marriages and marrying within the Jama'at.
- 2. Make reformatory plans to guide khuddam on how to tackle marital issues.
- 3. Increase the interest and participation of khuddam in Rishtanata system of the jama'at.

Activities and Achievements for the year 2023:

Rishtanata seminars were held at National and Ilaga levels to educate and appeal to our members the proper ways to choosing spouse, getting married, building and maintaining a noble family. They also revolve round dispute resolution and ways to curb marital challenges.

The Muhtamin Tarbiyah Rishtanata humbly represented the Sadr Majlis Khuddam in at least 16 Rishtanata resolution meeting summoned by the National Rishtanata commitee. These meetings resulted but not limited to:

- Reversal of at least 3 divorce decision between couples
- Resolution of custody dispute between 4 couples
- Resolution of property distribution in line with Islam's injunction between 2 families
- Sadly, we also painfully recorded several divorce cases after exhausting all lawful, and acceptable resolution avenues as guided by Islamic injunctions.

Further consultation, resolution and marital intervention still in progress with some other couples and families. All these activities and achievements were in collaboration with the National Rishtanata Department as well as the National Islahi Committee, in following the activation of nizame Jama`at.

Recommendation

Couples need to pray more, be open minded to discussing their challenges with the aim of helping each other through the troubling time.

Couples should make out time to unwind and not bottle-up emotions till it gets out of hand

The Rishtanata department needs a lot of database management and consolidation.

Conclusion.

It was observed that a whole lot of issues contributed to marital infractions as revealed by the meetings, complaints and resolutions deliberated upon. Some of them are:

- 1. Lack of trust between couples or dishonesty.
- 2. Issue of childlessness
- 3. Taking up of another wife by the husband (this could be a step taken rightly or wrongly by the husband which leads to further disagreement)
- 4. Lack of respect for each other, especially the husband in some cases.
- 5. Domestic violence, especially to the wife.
- 6. Unfair treatment of a certain wife in the case of polygamy.
- 7. Financial challenges.
- 8. Disregard for the sanctity institution of marriage especially when it involves a spouse travelling out of the country for work or greener Pasteur while the wife or husband remains in Nigeria. This has caused a whole lot of divorce and marital collapse.
- 9. Undue family influence especially as noticed from mothers-in-law
- 10. The 'Japa Syndrome'

We understand that marriage is a lifetime journey that reveals new peculiarities every day and it comes with the challenges as well. We always advice that couples should be determined to face their challenges and find solutions rather than abandon each other or abscond.

We pray that Almighty Allah forgive us and grant us the opportunity to do better and touch other areas which we are yet to cover in our mandate. There are still a lot to be done.

NAO MUBAEEN (NEW CONVERTS)

For the year, the department was able to gain 25 more new converts as reported from different llagaat

The department also worked in collaboration with Tabligh and Tarbiyyat department in training the new converts. Alhamdulilah, the department is able to device her own scheme of work to train the new converts which centred on lessons from yasarnal Quran, Salat Muslim prayer book and prayers of Holy prophet.

The department plan to have the first nationwide ijtema of nau mubain but this was not achieved due to time constraints but insha'Allah we hope it shall come to pass in the new imarat year. Even if not nationwide probably regional wise, subject to the approval of the respected Sadr sahib.

65% of the Ilaquat, 50% Dilaat and 45% Muqamaat reported following the National work plan.

UMOOR-E-TALABAH (STUDENTS AFFAIRS)

Introduction:

With the directive of Sadr sahib, the Department of Umoortulaba organized the MKAN Academic Seminar. This seminar was designed to sensitize and prepare members for careers in academics, aligning with the forthcomng launch of Minaret University.

2.2. Seminar Objectives:

The MKAN Academic Seminar aimed to achieve the following objectives:

- Career Awareness: Raise awareness among members about the importance of pursuing careers in academics.
- Skill Enhancement: Equip participants with essential skills required for success in academia, including research, presentation, and critical thinking skills.
- University Preparation: Provide insights into the upcoming Minaret University and its offerings, encouraging members to consider academic pathways.

2.3. Implementation:

The seminar was organized as a full-day event, featuring keynote speakers, panel discussions, and interactive workshops. Esteemed academics and professionals were invited to share their insights and experiences, highlighting the opportunities and challenges of pursuing careers in academia.

2.4. Continual Sensitization:

The sensitization process initiated through the MKAN Academic Seminar will continue as Minaret University prepares to commence. Regular updates, workshops, and mentoring sessions will ensure that members are wellprepared to embrace academic pursuits.

3. Positive Impact of Amsa Discussions and Recent Tabligh Program:

3.1. Amsa Discussions:

Regular discussions involving both executive and general members of AMSA have proven to be highly beneficial. These interactions provide a platform for brainstorming, idea-sharing, and strategic planning. The synergy among members has led to the successful implementation of various programs, including recent initiatives.

3.2. Recent Tabligh Program:

2. Admission And Commencement Of Second Cohort

By the grace of Allah, admission process for the second cohort was concluded in August 2023 with 42 trainees offered provisional admission. The first weekend camp held between 25th and 27th of August with 30 trainees resuming.

3. Internship and Collaboration

Participation Overview

A total of 19 local chapters, spanning various regions in Nigeria, actively participated in this year's event. Together, they planted an impressive 68 trees. A remarkable 81 members, along with 40 guests, joined forces for this noble cause, collectively contributing 845 minutes of their time.

Moreover, this initiative extended beyond local chapters, encompassing 19 districts and regions across the country. These districts and regions united to plant 106 trees, with 189 members and 68 quests actively participating, dedicating 910 minutes to this endeavor.

Notably, 10 states also made significant contributions by planting 175 trees. In these states, 109 members and 40 guests played pivotal roles, investing a total of 489 minutes in our shared mission.

In summary, for the year 2023, our collective efforts resulted in the planting of an impressive 349 trees, accompanied by the presence of 379 members and 148 guests, who dedicated a total of 2244 minutes to this critical initiative. It is noteworthy that these efforts build upon the solid foundation of the over 3000 trees previously planted.
